Business Golf Etiquette

Golf professional James Stith offers these pointers when golfing with the boss or clients:

- Wear appropriate golf clothes and shoes; if in doubt, call the club and ask about its dress code.
- Arrive at least 20 minutes before tee time.
- Turn off cell phones and pagers.
- Don't talk or rustle food wrappers when another golfer is teeing up.
- When it's your turn, be prepared to play quickly; only take one practice swing.
- Drive the cart at a safe speed and stay on the cart path; exit the cart when others do.
- Don't look for a lost ball more than five minutes.
- Keep score accurately.
- While golfing, don't discuss business unless the boss or client brings it up first. Otherwise, save it for after the game.

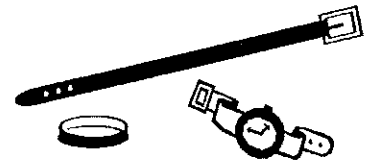


Don't Fight Others' Battles

Dr. Karissa Thacker, a workplace psychologist, says it's not uncommon for feuding co-workers to try to pull others into their conflicts, but she warns that it's often a bad idea. "Avoid getting drawn into battles that are not yours to fight," she says. "Be emotionally mature and savvy enough to stay out of other people's fights, especially people above you in hierarchy. The biggest hook is thinking that you are going to help two people who don't like each other — you are not."

According to business etiquette consultant Ann Marie Sabath, professional men should wear no more than three accessories — belt, wedding band, and watch.



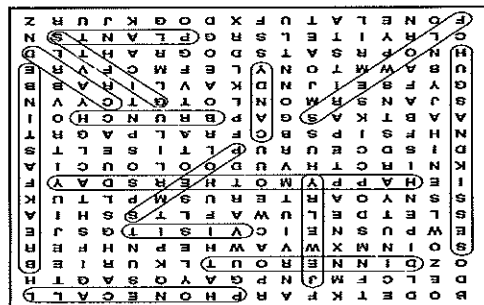

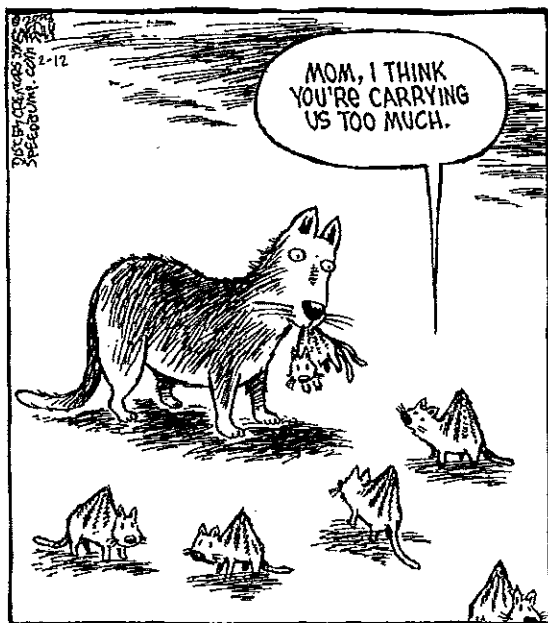

Recipe of the Month - A Simple Salsa Recipe

For a delicious and healthy salsa, try this recipe:

- 2 large ripe tomatoes, chopped
- 1/2 cup mild or sweet onion, chopped
- 1/4 cup fresh cilantro, chopped
- 1 tablespoon fresh lime juice

Combine these four ingredients in a bowl and let sit for five minutes or longer to allow the flavors to marinate.
